Course load is four courses per semester of Italian at all levels. The position also requires participation in student and department-related activities. Ph.D. or ABD preferred, but candidates must have at minimum an M.A. or equivalent in Italian or Applied Linguistics as well as previous experience in college-level Italian-language instruction. Ability to teach another modern language or a classical language desirable. Beside the four majors and minors (French, German, Spanish, Comparative Cultures and Literary Studies), the Department also offers language programs in Chinese, Italian and Japanese. Native or near-native fluency in Italian required. Required Qualifications: Minimum M.A. or equivalent in Italian or Applied Linguistics. Training in current approaches to language pedagogy, and previous experience in college-level Italian-language instruction. Commitment to the Jesuit Mission. Desired Qualifications: ABD or Ph.D. preferred. Ability to teach another modern language or a classical language.
