The North Carolina School of the Arts invites applications for a visiting instructor of Italian for 2008-2009, with the possibility that the position will become permanent. Responsibilities include two sections of Elementary and one section of Intermediate Italian per term. The Master's degree or Italian Laurea in Italian is required; the Ph.D. is optional but preferred. Top preference will be given to candidates with strong classroom language teaching experience at the college level, with qualifications for a possible additional course in an area of Western Civilization or cultural history. Experience in or passion for the performing arts is an asset. The North Carolina School of the Arts trains students from middle school through graduate school for careers in the performing, visual, and film and television arts in five professional schools: Dance, Design and Production (including a Visual Arts Program), Drama, Filmmaking, and Music. With its full academic program, the School is accredited to award the high school diploma, the College Arts Diploma, the Professional Artist Certificate, and bachelor's and master's degrees.
