Candidates should be able to demonstrate serious scholarly promise, commitment to teaching, native or near-native Italian and English, and willingness to participate fully in a vibrant program with strong ties to neighboring disciplines in humanities, arts, and social sciences. Dissertation should be completed before taking up appointment.
